

Wage subsidy program extended and uncapped

- 12 month 50% wage subsidy, up to \$7k per quarter
- Open to new workers & workers with a change to employment status

As of May 11 2021, the Federal Government announced the extension of the Boosting Apprenticeship Commencements (BAC) program. The program will subsidise 50% of gross wages paid to eligible trainees between 5 October 2020 and 31 March 2022 for for a 12-month period from the date of commencement, to a maximum of \$7,000 per quarter.

The subsidy is no longer capped and is open to employers of any size or industry, Australia-wide, for both new and existing workers studying a Certificate II or higher qualification as part of a formal training contract (who are not receiving any other form of government subsidy, e.g., JobKeeper).
